Parent Code of Conduct**

Prior to competing in our Summer Series, the member's parent must have on file with UYRC a signed Parent Code of Conduct. The code of conduct is as follows:

Parents are expected to:

1. Remember that children participate in rodeos to have fun and that the rodeos are for children, not adults.
2. Know the rules of the association and follow them.
3. Present a positive role model for all contestants and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy to other contestants and parents.
4. Demonstrate positive support for all contestants, judges, officials, and spectators at every rodeo and event associated with UYRC.
5. Refrain from any type of unsportsmanlike conduct with any judge, official, contestant, or parent such as booing, taunting or using profane language or gestures during the rodeo.
6. Act to prevent and behaviors that could endanger the health or well-being of the contestants, or stock.
7. Encourage their child to follow the rules in a positive manner.
8. Encourage their child to treat fellow contestants, judges, and officials with respect regardless of race, creed, sex, or ability.
9. Not ridicule or yell at their child or other contestants for making mistakes or losing a competition.
10. Respect the judges and officials by following the rules for questions about calls or procedures and not confront judges or officials in the arena or the stands during the event.
11. Adhere to the rules forbidding alcohol in the arena during rodeos.
12. Remember that the primary purpose of the youth rodeo is to promote the kids, horses, family, and sportsmanlike conduct that will help serve our youth well into their future.
